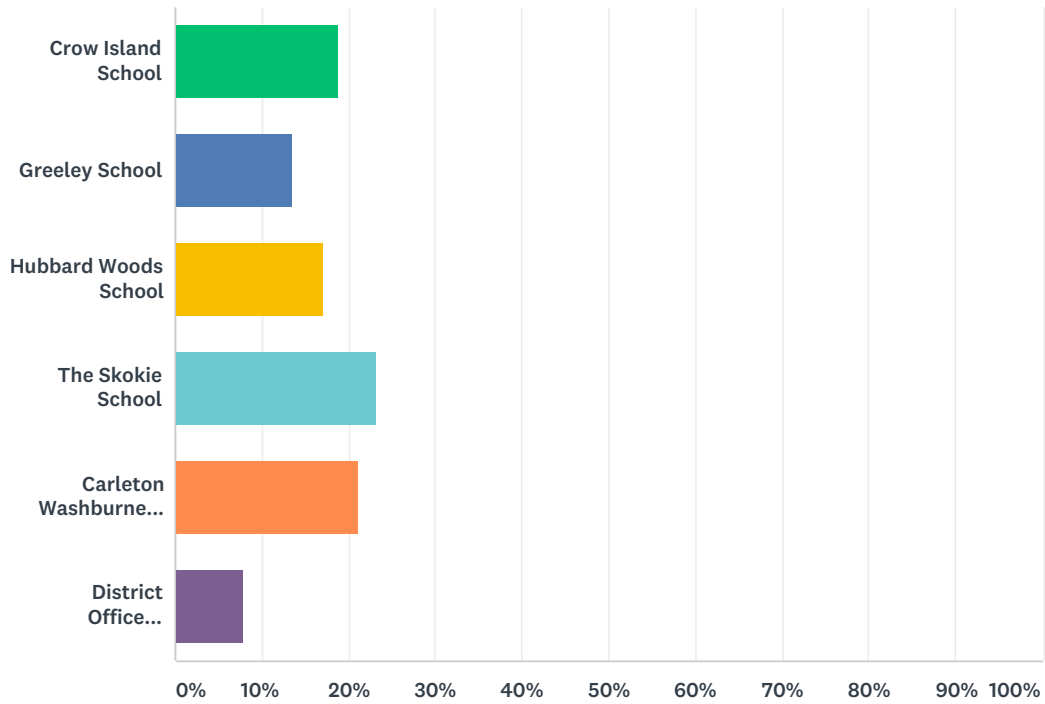


Q1 At which site do you primarily work?

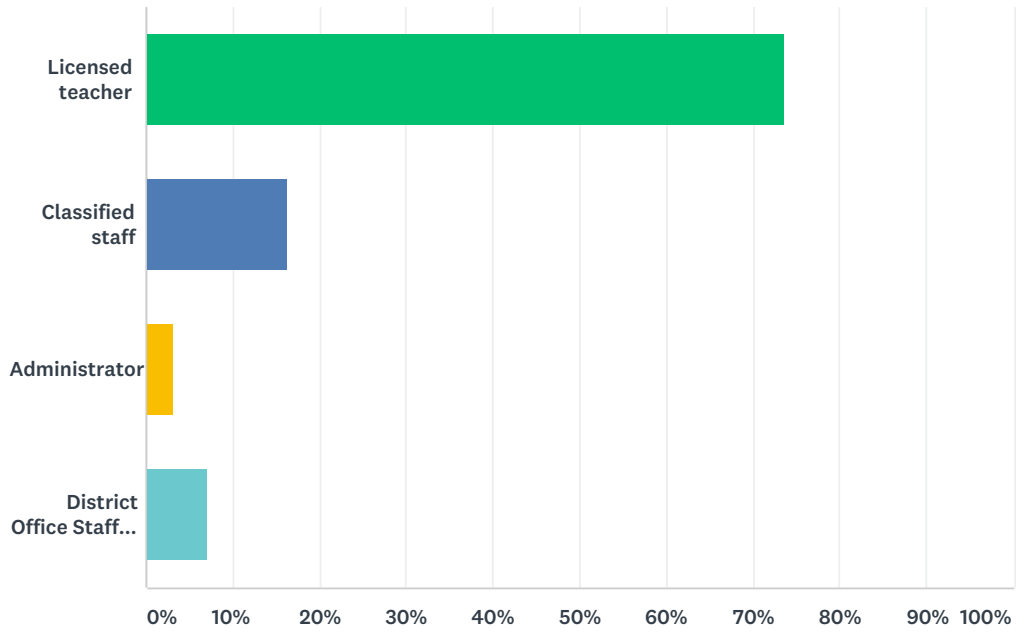

Q2 Which of the following best describes your role at The Winnetka Public Schools?

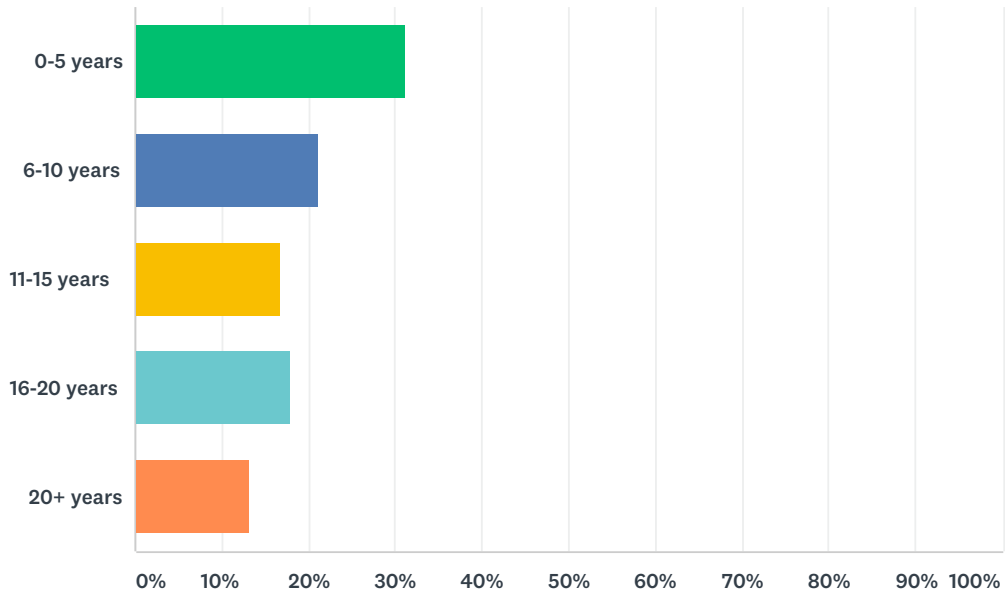

Q3 How long have you been an employee of The Winnetka Public Schools?

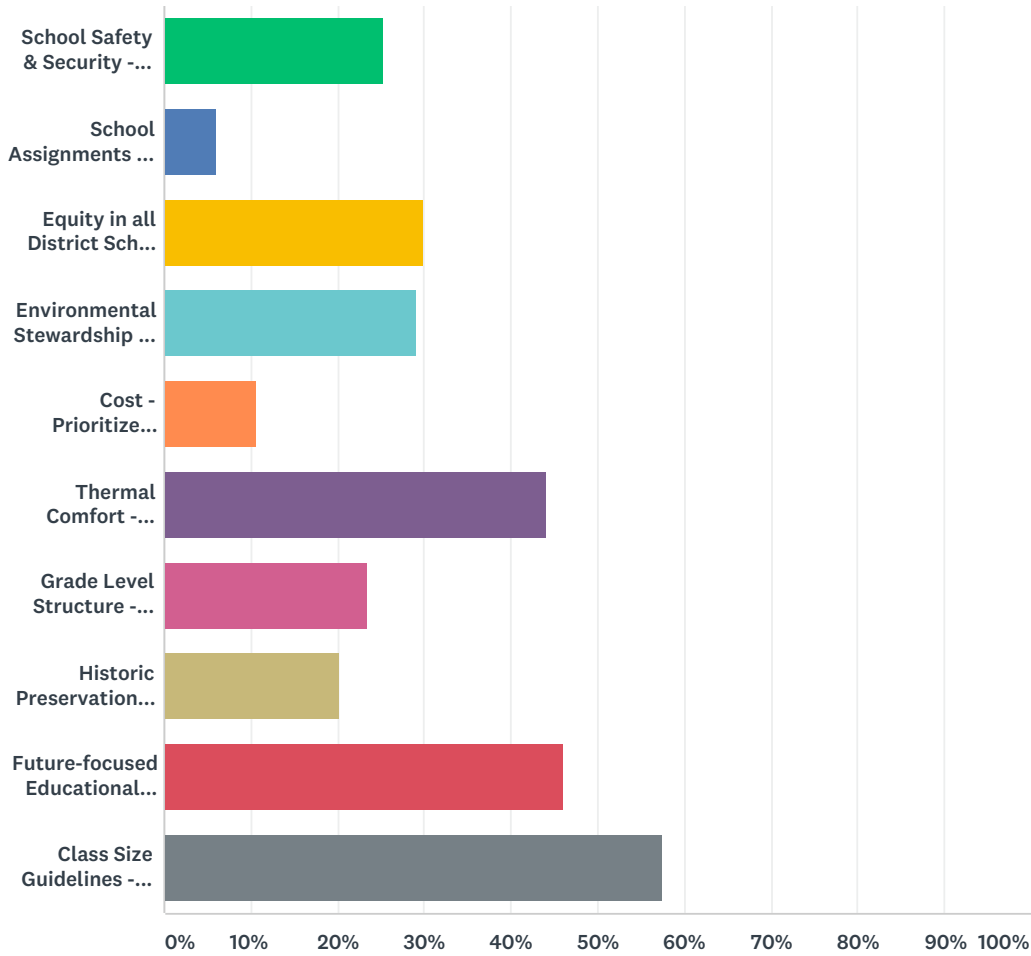

School Safety & Security - Support modern safety and security measures and current best practices in concert with local law enforcement in the design, construction, maintenance and operation of all District facilities.	25.35% 55
School Assignments - When possible, avoid moving students from their current school assignments.	5.99% 13
Equity in all District School Spaces - Ensure facilities allow for equitable delivery of academic and specialized programming at all District schools. This includes equitable spaces for makerspaces, small group learning, gym space, the arts, etc.	29.95% 65
Environmental Stewardship & Sustainability - Support and protect the environment and strengthen sustainable practices, which includes cost-saving energy practices. Such considerations include renewable energy, resource recovery, water conservation, and waste minimization.	29.03% 63
