

**DISTRICT #36 EARLY CHILDHOOD SCREENING
For Winnetka Residents 3-5 Years Old**

If you are a Winnetka resident and have any concerns about your child's development in the areas of speech, language, coordination, hearing, vision, learning readiness, or emotional maturity, you are encouraged to register your child for an early childhood screening. The intent of the screening is to identify children who may have delays in their development and may require specific supports to address these delays. To be eligible for this screening, your child must be at least three years old.

Parents should register their children at The Winnetka Public Schools District Office (1235 Oak Street) at the time listed below. Please bring a certified copy of your child's birth certificate that will be copied and returned to you. Proof of residency (mortgage statement or lease, a copy of your driver's license, *and* a copy of a recent utility bill) is also required. It is *not* necessary to bring your child/children with you to registration, nor is it mandatory to have the screening done for entrance to preschool or kindergarten.

Registration will take approximately 30 minutes. Parents will be asked to complete a questionnaire and be provided with times for hearing and vision screenings, and an appointment for the early childhood screening.
